Topics are as follows:

On **Saturday October 31st 2009** from **9am to 5pm**: Myra will cover the topics from her book:

Canine Reproduction and Whelping: This book gets down to the basics of breeding, explaining the characteristics of the sperm and the egg, the role that diet plays in whelping, and how to whelp your puppies. The book is intended to assist you in making sure your bitches get in whelp, stay in whelp and deliver healthy puppies. A clean, bloodless technique for the removal of dew claws is also taught to the layman dog breeder.

On **Sunday November 1st 2009** from **9am to 3pm**: Myra will cover the topics from her book:

Puppy Intensive Care: a wonderful book which teaches dog breeders all of the techniques that they need to know in order to set up a Puppy Intensive Care Unit and deliver the support that their sick puppies need. The book teaches how to tube feed, utilize subcutaneous hydration methods and deliver oxygen to pups that would otherwise die. You will learn how to do the things you need to do to keep your puppy losses to a

minimum. The book comes with an instructional DVD, as well, that demonstrates the hands-on skills that every dog breeder needs.
